



# Diploma-to-Degree Program

## Sandermoen Scholarship Opportunity

The University of Fredericton is pleased to announce the Sandermoen Scholarship opportunity for Diploma-to-Degree students who are pursuing a Bachelor's Degree in either Business Administration or Criminal Justice. The University of Fredericton will grant one \$4000.00 scholarship to aid a student in his or her educational endeavors in these specialized fields. The scholarship money awarded will be in Canadian funds and will be applied directly toward the student's tuition.

The eligible programs are in partnership with Husson University and are:

- Bachelor of Science Degree in Business Administration
- Bachelor of Science Degree in Criminal Justice

The **Sandermoen Scholarship** recipient will receive \$400.00 per course provided that the student remains in good standing in the program and achieves a letter grade of "B" or higher. The amount of \$400.00 will be applied toward ten of the required courses for the completion of the degree, up to a maximum amount of \$4000.00. Failure to maintain the minimum grade in any particular course will result in the loss of the scholarship.

Scholarship applicants must be current students who have been accepted to and enrolled in courses in the Diploma-to-Degree program. Applicants must complete and submit the [Sandermoen Scholarship Application Form](#) along with all supporting documentation prior to the deadline date, as well as meet all of the following criteria:

The applicant must:

- be a Canadian Public Community College graduate with a two-year diploma in either Business or the Criminal Justice field,
- have graduated on the "Dean's List" from his or her program of study and have achieved a minimum grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale, (or an overall letter grade of "B" or higher),
- be recommended by a faculty member or Department Head of the college they attended,
- be employed or actively searching for employment in an environment that will lead to an advanced degree of responsibility, and
- be accepted to and enrolled in the online Diploma-to-Degree Program offered in

partnership by Husson University and the University of Fredericton.

Who is eligible to apply?

- Applicants must have completed a two-year diploma program in Business or the Criminal Justice field at a Canadian Public Community College with a minimum grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale, or an overall letter grade of "B" or higher.
- Applicants must be accepted to and enrolled in the online Diploma-to-Degree Program offered in partnership by Husson University and the University of Fredericton.

What is the scholarship amount?

- The Sandermoen Scholarship amount is a maximum of \$4000.00 (\$400.00 per course, up to ten courses). One scholarship will be awarded per academic school year.

How are the scholarships awarded?

- Awarded scholarships are based on an individual's completed application, college transcripts and grade point average, resume, personal statement, and financial need.
- Recipients must maintain a grade of 'B' or higher in each course throughout the Diploma-to-Degree Program in order to maintain their scholarship status.

How do I apply?

- Applications are available through the University of Fredericton and may be accessed by clicking on the following link: [Sandermoen Scholarship Application Form](#). Please print and submit your completed application form along with all other required documentation prior to the deadline date.

What is the application deadline?

- Completed applications and all supporting documentation must be received by October 10, 2011.

How many awards will be granted?

- The University of Fredericton will issue one scholarship per academic school year.

What do I have to do?

- Applicants must complete an application form and email, fax or mail along with all other supporting documentation to the University of Fredericton.
- Applicants must be in good academic standing (a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale) and currently be enrolled in the Diploma-to-Degree Program.
- Have the Canadian Public Community College mail an official transcript to the University of Fredericton.

- Submit two letters of recommendation: one must be from a professor, faculty member or department head, and the other may be from an employer or someone who is familiar with the applicant's character. (Recommendations from family members are not acceptable).
- Submit a current resume.
- Submit a one-page personal statement indicating why you should receive the Sandermoen Scholarship.
- All applications and supporting documentation **must** be received by **October 10, 2011**.
